

Signals in use at the Meeting

The Green Flag is dropped at the starting line when the race is on. During the race it signifies that the course is clear. The Yellow Flag warns drivers to use caution, but not to change positions. It is used when "wide open" driving is not permitted. The Red Flag is used to denote that the race has been stopped, and the Black Flag to order a car off the track. The Chequered Flag indicates the end of a race.
